Stewards Brief Health Safety and Security

Apart from your specific duties as steward, during your period of duty, we are asking for your co-operation to monitor the general safety and security of the Minster.

Our concern is the vandal and arsonist. DO NOT BECOME INVOLVED, but if you have observed someone behaving in a suspicious manner, IMMEDIATELY INFORM THE DUTY VERGER.

The Church is an ' Easy Target'.

Potential arsonists and vandals are now seeing churches as ' Easy Targets'.

Drug related crimes - offertory boxes and unattended vestries holding large amounts of cash in cupboards or easily opened safes.

Churches are attractive to the arsonist and vandal because:

- 1. Isolated locations.
- 2. Unoccupied for long periods.
- 3. Easy access for members of the public.
- 4. Considerable amounts of combustible materials.
- 5. Funds in short supply Fire protection receives low priority.
- 6.' Open Building ' policy open invitation to would-be arsonists.

FOLLOWING A RISK ASSESSMENT, ACCESS INTO THE MINSTER IS NOW CONTROLLED. IN AN EMERGENCY THE DUTY VERGER WILL ENSURE THAT EGRESS IS READILY AVAILABLE.

MAIN CAUSES OF FIRE IN CHURCHES.

- 1.10% caused by contractors.
- 2.20% caused by electrical faults.
- 3.70% Arson / fire rising.

Fire started to hide a crime.

Child playing with matches / candles found inside church.

Accidental moving of heater or moving item too close to heater / candle etc.

Lighting fire inside church for warmth by child / vagrant.

Lighting fire against or near wall of building, allowing fire to enter window or reach eaves.

FIRE LOSSES.

Anglican Churches:

1. 20 fires per day - small to large.

2. Vandalism - 20,000 claims per year on average.

3. In last ten years fire losses averaged £30 million. Arson losses averaged £15 million.

ACCIDENTS and INCIDENTS

- 1. Report all accidents and incidents to duty verger. Vergers are trained first aiders.
- 2. If you see anything, which may cause an accident, report it. TO IGNORE IT IS TO CONDONE AN ACCIDENT.

CONCERTS.

When acting as a concert steward ensure that:

a) You have been fully briefed by the Duty Verger.

b) Always have your torch with you. Does it work?

c) If you are issued with a radio, can you use it?

- d) Know how to open the doors fully.
- e) Keep the gangways clear.

f) No loose chairs allowed.

- g) All chairs must be fastened.
- h) Designated area for wheelchairs.

IF YOU HAVE A PROBLEM CALL THE DUTY VERGER.

TOWER VISITS.

Tower visits are subjected to the following conditions:

- 1. Maximum parties of 15 persons.
- 2. Persons under 16 years must be accompanied.
- 3. No child under 7 years allowed to go up the tower.
