FACT SHEET No 129

SOUTHWELL MINSTER CHAPTER HOUSE CAPITALS [The numbers start from the left on entering]

- 1. *IVY* Leaves with berries in two layers. Above this a defaced face showing damage from a sharp instrument.
- 2. BUTTERCUP One flower plus leaves. Above this an eroded animal. ? water damage.
- 3. VINE Leaves plus grapes. Above this a female head wearing a cap.
- 4. BUTTERCUP with flowers and large leaves (traces of colour). Above this a male head with much damaged head and arms.

GREENMAN

- 5. MAPIB showing winged fruit. Nail head decoration at bottom and top of frieze. One buttercup leaf immediately above. Above this a head with curly hair.
- 6. BUTTERCUP with good flowers. 3 oak leaves immediately above. Above this a ball- flower.

GREEN MAN with hop/strawberry

- 7. IVY badly defaced and broken. Berries behind on right. 4 hawthorn leaves above on stem. Above this a damaged female head.
- 8. BUT1ER.CUP with flowers. Nothing above.
- 9. ROSE Double rose (10 petals) with flowers and leaves. Above this male head wearing large cap. By tradition this could be the master mason.
- 10 HOP showing hops with a vine/buttercupleaf above.
- 11. VINE showing grapes with ivy above. Above this a damaged female head
- 12. OAK showing galls on leaves with a spray of 5 oak leaves above. Above this a winged mystical beast.
- 13. BUTTERCUP with flowers and hop/buttercup above. Above this a male head wearing a flat cap.
- 14. HOP showing hops. Nail head frieze top and bottom. Above this a very damaged figure with a clear hand showing.
- 15. BRYONY showing berries and tendrils. Another nail head frieze top and bottom. Above this vine and grapes.

GREEN MAN with birds

16. MAPLE - damaged - no fruits. Merman above. A-hove this male head with similar cap to head on CAP 9.

17. ACANTHUS - Traditional stiff leaf above buttercup. Above his male head with flat cap similar to CAP 13.

GREENMAN with cherry/arrowhead?

- 18. *IVY* showing berries. Garlanded head above with traces of colour. ?May Queen.
- 19. MAPLE with winged fruit above acanthus leaf.
- 20. VINE with fruit Mythical creature (dragon/basilisk) under. Above this a bishop.
- 21. VINE with grapes. Nothing immediately above. Above this a female with a fancy headdress.
- 22. HAWTRORN with hemp nettle growing through. Above this a male head. ?mason.
- 23. OAK WITH ACORNS badly worn. oak leaves and cups above.
- 24. *IVY* with berries and hare and hounds. A lion above. Above this a ball flower.
- 25. HOP above female with headdress. Above this a much eroded head.
- 26. HOP badly damaged. Could this be a bird/basilisk/fighting cocks? Above this an eroded head.
- 27. BUTTERCUP badly damaged Eroded head of lion above. Over this a ball-flower.

GREENMAN

- 28. *IVY* with a few berries. Badly damaged but possible bird/basilisk? Above this a badly worn female head.
- 29. VINE with grapes and trace of colour. acanthus leaf above.
- 30. OAK with acorns and possible bird/basilisk? Acanthus leaf above. Above this a female head.
- 31. HAWTHORN showing bunches of flowers. A green man above. Above this a damaged mystical beast.

GREENMAN

- 32. OAK Leaves with acorn and empty acorn cup. Pigs under. Above this a damaged female head with headdress.
- 33. HAWTHORN Damaged but with berries and remains of bird/basilisk? A damaged head of lion above.
- 34. HOP showing hops. Well ribbed leaves above with a spray of hawthorn. Above this a garlanded head.

GREEN MAN with rose

- 35. BUTTERCUP with flowers above. A leaf with turned-over tip. Above this a damaged beast.
- 36. VINE plus grapes. 3 buttercup leaves above. Above this a man with moustache and beard.
- 37. HOP with hops. Oak leaves and acorns above. Above this a ball-flower.
- 38. HAWTHORN with berries. Above this a lion with curly mane.
- 39. MAPLE leaves only. Nothing above.
- 40. BUTTERCUP leaves only. Buttercup leaf above. Above this head bearing a crown.

GREEN MAN with hawthorn

- 41. OAK with acorns. damaged animal with large ears. Nice ballflower above.
- 42. BRYONY with berries. bryony above. Above this a man's head with tonsure.
- 43. HAWTHORN with berries. Oak leaves above. Above this a green man with face covered with hawthorn leaves.

GREENMAN

- 44. BUTTERCUP .Leaves only. Above this a bishop.
- 45. BUTTERCUP Leaves only.
