

Ronald Sims was the next Architect to the Minster. He worked in an easily recognisable style, very rarely leaving a flat surface. Most of his designs were made and installed by Houghtons of York. They include the Bishops and Provosts boards at the west end of the nave, the inner porch to the north door, the paschal candle stand, the nave altar and chairs and the upper part of the screen to the Pilgrims' Chapel (this was delivered and fitted the day before the Queen came on Maundy Thursday 1984). The furniture in the chapel was also designed by Sims.
