A Over the Font.



A. On the tapestry in the Pilgrim Chapel





4. Where is there a tiny carved wooden dove?

A. In the Quire on the front of the pulpit there is a tiny dove hovering over Jesus' hand.

3. Can you find a dove that makes you think of peace after war?A. On the Triptuch in the Airmonial Changel

5. Can you find a dove bringing a message to Mary?

A Two places (a) in the nave in the window opposite the North Door. (b) in the Airmen's Chapel, in the roundel at the bottom of one of the north facing windows.






6. Where is there a dove hovering over Jesus' head? What is happening?

A Two places (a) in the window behind the font and (b) in the window over the High Altar (first left). In both Jesus is being baptised by St John.





7. Can you see a little dove with lots of animal friends?

A. On a small embroidered hanging in the Children's Comer-west end of the south aisle of the nave.

9. Can you find an angel holding the flames of the Holy Spirit?

A. In the nave high up in the West Window, the larger angel on the right-hand side of the Virgin Mary (as viewed).

8. Can you find a dove in a cage? What is happening in this story?

A. In a window on the south side of St Oswald's Chapel . Jesus is being presented to the Lord, and Simeon is giving thanks that he has at last seen Jesus. The dove is for a sacrifice to the Lord. (See Luke chapter 2; verses 21- 34.)
