# A reflection on our planet 'The earth is the Lord's and all that is in it; the compass of the world and those who dwell therein. For he has founded it upon the seas; and established it upon the waters.' Psalm 24; 102

The Minster is one of the UK's 53 'Partners in Action' of *A Rocha*, an international organization committed to caring for God's Creation. *A Rocha* embraces many cultural and Church traditions, yet is united in its desire to be faithful to Jesus and to demonstrating Christ's Lordship in caring for God's world. Our 2025 'Listening to the Leaves' leaflets will explore *A Rocha*'s seven-point biblical basis for its work.

God delights in the natural world in all its beauty, wildness and mystery, declaring it "very good". 2. <u>Our knowledge of God</u> comes through our relationship with Jesus Christ and commitment to the Word of God in the Bible, and our experience of Creation in worship, relationship, creativity; also in the scientific investigation of life and its intricate interconnections and dependences.

<u>Week 4</u> Again , with COP30 being in the heart of the Amazon, continue to pray for indigenous peoples the world over already suffering from climate change.

<u>Week 4</u> Pray for food producers worldwide. When things go wrong due to climate problems our prices go up worldwide - but the poor don't eat at all.


